

**District English Learners Advisory Committee**  
**DELAC Minutes**  
**March 15, 2019**

**A. OPENING PROCEDURES**

- a. Call to Order** Bonner Montler introduced himself, called the meeting to order at 9:13 A.M., and reviewed the committee charge.
- b. Review and Approve Agenda** Bonner reviewed the agenda. Lily Kumke motioned to approve it. Elizabeth Perez seconded the motion. The ayes voted to approve the agenda.

**B. PUBLIC COMMUNICATION**

A parent asked about the notification of DELAC meetings. Bonner explained that a phone messenger and a flyer go out to notify parents. The parent explained that people receive those notifications, but don't understand what the DELAC meetings are. Bonner said they will explore other means to get more parents to participate in these meetings.

Mrs. Soma wanted more clarification about attendance. Bonner stated that parents need to call the attendance clerk when students are ill. Chronic absenteeism occurs if the student is absent more than 18 days a year. Religious holidays can be excused for up to 4 days a year.

**C. AGENDA ITEMS**

- a. Approval of January Minutes** Bonner reviewed the January minutes. Elizabeth Perez motioned to approve them. Marisela Villalva seconded the motion. The ayes approved them.
- b. (ELPAC) English Language Proficiency Assessment** Next year the ELPAC will be taken online.
- c. Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) Stakeholder Input Session** Bonner discussed the way the state department funds schools. The district must outline how it intends to spend funding. The Santee School District's LCAP document was distributed to members and reviewed by Bonner. He reviewed California's Eight State Priority Areas and Santee's Goals, and how the district will use the funding to address the goals. Bonner invited the committee to respond to questions regarding *Conditions of Learning, Pupil Outcomes, and Engagement*. Bonner showed how to access the LCAP online so members can provide further feedback.
- d. California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) Parent** Bonner explained that CAASPP testing will begin in April. Parent information is located on the Santee School District website under the Parent Resource tab. Fifth and Eighth grades will be tested in science beginning this year.
- e. Rosetta Stone for Parents** Parents with children in our district can enroll in Rosetta Stone.
- f. Next Meeting** The next meeting will be April 12, 2019 from 9:00 A.M. to 10:30 A.M.
