

What is EAK? EAK is a state funded Early Admission to Kindergarten program designed for children who will be 5 years old by May 31, 2023

Who can attend? Children must be five years old on or before May 31, 2023 to be eligible for EAK. Space is limited, however, we will do our best to accommodate all Santee School District residents who enroll on-line with completed applications by December 1, 2022. Applicants from other districts are welcome to apply and will be placed if space is available. Participation in the program is voluntary and is not designed to take the place of kindergarten.
