**HISTORY**—In November 2006, the voters within Santee School District approved a \$60 million dollar General Obligation Bond. In May 2007, the first \$18 million in bonds were sold to fund planning and improvements. This bond funding is only a portion of a much larger capital improvement program currently amounting to \$127 million.

#### **\$7,800,000 GRANT FROM STATE**

The Santee School District applied & received a \$7.8 million grant from the State to supplement the Bond funded construction of Library/Technology Centers and Multi-purpose rooms.



#### **PROJECTS COMPLETED DURING SUMMER 2007**

 Turf at Carlton Hills, Carlton Oaks, Hill Creek and Prospect Avenue with City collaboration and Parking Lot at Pepper Drive.







#### **PROJECTS PLANNED FOR 2007/2008**

- Santee School District is working with Chevron Energy Solutions for Photo Voltaic Systems to provide shade and Green/Clean Electricity.
   Potentially five schools may be eligible. They are Cajon Park, Carlton Hills, Carlton Oaks, Hill Creek, and Rio Seco.
- Intruder protection security door locks will be installed at all classrooms.





#### **PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT**

 Playground equipment will be installed at all schools within the next 18 months.
