Administration

PRINCIPAL AND VICE PRINCIPAL ROTATION

The Governing board believes periodic rotation of school principals may enhance professional growth and thereby improve the quality of education. The Board therefore delegates to the Superintendent or designee responsibility for rotating assignments.

Rotation will be made at the discretion of the Superintendent or designee, <u>subject to Board</u> <u>approval</u>, based on the best instructional leadership for the specific school and the welfare of students, schools, community, staff and principals. Individual principal desires and interest will be taken into consideration.

Rotation of assignments may not change at regular intervals but will be considered on an asneeded basis.
