LCAP Comments and Superintendent's Response

- 1. <u>Question</u>: Regarding the digital initiative, how will the district engage parents who are limited English speaking in learning how to help their children use the device?
 - <u>Response</u>: The Santee School District will be providing training to parents in both English and Spanish. Other languages will be accommodated as needed. Training will include an introduction to the iPad, IOS Basics, specific apps, and online learning resources and materials.
- 2. Question: Will parents be trained to use the device?
 - <u>Response</u>: Yes, the Santee School District will provide parent training. The parent training will include information on how to navigate and use the device. See response to Question 1 for more information.
- 3. *Question*: Will TOSA's be assisting classified staff as well as teachers?
 - <u>Response</u>: The Santee School District operates as a collaborative team and believes in creating a culture of learning for everyone. Classified staff will be trained by a variety of individuals, including TOSAs. In addition, the District will have professional development opportunities open to both classified and certificated staff.
- 4. <u>Question</u>: For the homework clubs, will a late bus be available for students who receive transportation?
 - Response: We do not provide transportation for afterschool clubs.
- 5. Question: Which schools will offer the homework clubs?
 - Response: All schools will offer a homework club.
